## Health Check and Maintenance

To participate or attend - all participants, volunteers, coaches, and spectators must show no signs or symptoms of COVID-19 for 14 days. Current list of symptoms is available from the [CDC](#). If any individual develops symptoms of COVID-19 during the activity, they should promptly inform organizers and must be removed from the activity and instructed to return home.

Participants and Spectators should take their temperature before leaving home . Stay home if you have a fever or any symptoms at all.

## Sanitization

All individuals must sanitize their hands upon departing from their vehicle and again before entering their vehicle. All individuals should be equipped with their own personal sanitizer

## General Protocols, all fields:

Parents are asked to remain in their vehicles until FIVE minutes prior to kickoff. This will eliminate the flow of parents crossing from one game to another. Five minutes will leave you more than enough time at each location to walk from your car to the field to see your child's game.

Only ONE spectator per player will be permitted.

Spectators MUST wear a mask at all times. Spectators not in masks will be asked to return to their vehicle.

All spectators should maintain a safe social distance of 6 feet from the next closest spectator.

At the conclusion of their match, all players and spectators should immediately return to their vehicle and leave the facility immediately. We would like to prevent groups of people congregating near the fields before, during or after matches.

Teams will be expected to provide match balls for their scheduled matches. This is to prevent extra exposure from using the same match balls for several matches in a single day.

### **Videographers:**

### **Facility Specific Rules**

#### **Union Point Field 1 & 2 (The Bubble[s]):**

NO SPECTATORS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BUBBLE(S)

All players and coaches must use the clearly defined entrance and exit to this field. The field entrance for Field 1 is the revolving door closest to the parking lot for Fields 1 and 2. The field exit for Field 1 will be the revolving door at the opposite end.

Any player or coach exhibiting a fever of any kind will not be permitted to participate in the event on that day and will be asked to leave the facility.

We will have event staff at the entrance and exit of the bubble.

#### **Union Point 3 & 4:**

Parents are not permitted on the turf area for any reason.

Only players, coaches, referees, and staff will be allowed onto the turf fields.

There are fences around each field which will allow for clear sight lines to still watch the matches, but we do not want to crowd the turf area.

Players and coaches must follow the signage on each field to enter and exit the field in an orderly fashion.

**Lovell Field:**

Field 1 - No parents will be permitted onto the turf field surface. Parents may choose to stand behind the walkway for Field 1 for 11v11 matches.

Field 2 - For 11v11 matches parents will be allowed on the turf side of the field closest to the pavilion area.

A camera crew will be present to record matches at these two fields. Please be mindful of the camera and do not crowd around it as this is for players and college coaches.

**Legion Field:**

Entry - When approaching the field from your vehicle please take the walkway to the left of the tennis courts as you walk towards them from the parking lot.

Exit - When exiting the field area we ask that all players and spectators take the walkway to the left as you face the tennis courts as you are walking away from the field.

There will be signs at this location to point crowds in the right direction.
